Honor donor's wishes Help donors to direct their gifts Segregated from General Funds and other Restricted Funds Held in trust by the charity for stated purpose only

Establishing a Restricted Fund

Established by Vestry decision or at the suggestion of donor or group of donors

Documentation

Clearly written purpose statement reflecting fiduciary care

Should be in accordance with any existing donor-restricted gift policy

Responsibilities

Corporation is trustee of Restricted Fund

- Subject to high standard of fiduciary care
- Fund can only be used in accordance with stated purpose

Maintaining the Fund

- May be invested if not used immediately
- Abide by "Prudent Investor rules"
- Not to be used to address general cash flow requirements (conflict of interest)
- Failure to comply may lead to personal liability

Administration

Must be properly tracked in financial records and statements

May be reported as a group of restricted funds with notes to break out each specifically named fund

Adding to Established Funds

Additions by Charity require additional tracking and segregation

Externally restricted may only to used for fund's stated purpose

Internally restricted may be used elsewhere without repercussions

Fund Expenditures

Allocations between externally and internally restricted funds must be established and tracked

Donor Restricted Gift Policy

- Helps charity comply with legal obligations
- Donations not accepted for projects outside of the charity's objects
- Avoids impractical gift giving
- Provides opportunity to use excess funds for other purposes

Donor Restricted Gift Policy Sample

- Spending of funds confined to (Charity's) approved programs and projects
- Contributions direct to an approved program or project will be used as restricted with the understanding.....

Donor Restricted Gift Policy Sample....

...that when the need for such a program or project has been met, or cannot be completed for any reason as determined by the (Charity), the remaining restricted contributions will be used where most needed.

Communication of Policy

Donors must be aware of policy when charity solicits or accepts restricted funds

Donor must agree to policy <u>at the</u> <u>time the gift is made</u>

Donor has no rights <u>after</u> gift is made

Communication of Policy

Must be clearly communicated and printed on all materials provided to prospective donors

- Must not be abused or taken advantage of by Charity
- Funds redirected only as absolutely necessary
