

MEMORIALS

1 Forms of Memorial

Under [Canon Six](#), s. 11(10), the Diocesan Council prescribes the following Forms relating to the issuance of Memorials by the Bishop:

- a) Notice of Intention to Issue a Memorial which shall be in Form 6A
- b) Memorial of Adjustment, which shall be in Form 6B
- c) Memorial of Amalgamation; which shall be in Form 6C
- d) Memorial of Dissolution, which shall be in Form 6D
- e) Memorial of Division, which shall be in Form 6E
- f) Affidavit of Execution by Bishop, which shall be in Form 6F.

2 [Register of Parish Memorials, Names, Boundaries and Communities](#)

- 2(1) Under [Canon Six](#), s. 11(11), the Diocesan Council adopts the Register of Parish Memorials, Names, Boundaries and Communities, which shall be in Form 6G
- 2(2) The Secretary of the Synod, with the assistance of the Diocesan Archivist, shall maintain the Register of Parish Memorials, Names, Boundaries and Communities.
- 2(3) A copy of the Register of Parish Memorials, Names, Boundaries and Communities shall be kept in the Diocesan Synod Office and in the Diocesan Archives.
